

**CHEMIN NEUF COMMUNITY**

**PRIVACY POLICY  
AND  
DATA PROTECTION (RGPD)**

*Version 2.2 - 19 mai 2021*

The present policy of confidentiality and protection of personal data applies to the Chemin Neuf Congregation, as well as to the Hautecombe Foundation, the Chemin Neuf Association, the Chemin Neuf Workshops, the Olivier de la Coste, Henri Planchat, Le Navire, l'Etoile de la Mer, Les Bleuets du Pilat, the Association de Gestion de la Maison des Soeurs Aînées, the real estate company of the Tigery domain, and to 9.architecture In the rest of this text, the word "Community" or "we" applies to all these entities.

It aims at the correct application of the law n°78-17 of January 6, 1978 modified and the General Data Protection Regulation (RGPD - 2016/679) and any other text which would come to supplement or amend it.

### **WHAT DATA DO WE COLLECT?**

We collect the data necessary for the proper functioning of the Community and its mission. It can come from:

- directly from yourselves (e.g. your civil status, your registrations, your orders ...)
- from the services of the Community (e.g. your fraternities, your services ...)

They are collected when:

- you register for a service or a session of the Community
- you donate to the Community
- you place an order with the Community
- you establish a business relationship with the Community or are employed by it.

We do not collect data from third parties.

### **HOW IS THE DATA USED?**

We use the data to:

- Organize and run the weekends or sessions you have registered for
- Organize and animate the abbeys, spiritual centers, student residences and more broadly all the missions of the Community.
- To communicate to you information about what we offer
- To solicit the generosity of donors to support our missions.
- Respond to your orders from the Community's stores.

We do not transfer files to third parties.

### **HOW LONG DO WE USE THE DATA?**

We use the data for as long as you participate in the life or missions of the Community.

We continue to send you information, or solicit your generosity for 10 years after your last contact with the Community, unless, of course, you ask us to stop.

### **CAN THE DATA LEAVE THE EUROPEAN UNION?**

Data can be accessed from outside the European Union, provided that you have the required authorizations and that you respect the protection measures.

### **WHAT ARE YOUR RIGHTS?**

You have rights on the personal data concerning you. You can:

- ask for your personal data to be communicated to you
- ask that it be rectified
- object to their processing

For legal reasons, we may be obliged to keep for a certain period of time data that we no longer use at your request (for example copies of tax receipts).
